## A Level - Pupils study the CCEA GCE Applied Business Specification

Students who study GCE Applied Business (Single Award) will follow the CCEA Specification.

### AS Units

Unit 1: The Enterprising Business. This is an introductory unit, which gives the candidates an opportunity to gain an overview of the enterprising business and how it creates market opportunities.

Unit 2: The Enterprising Manager. This unit gives an overview of how the enterprising manager uses Finance and People effectively.

Unit 3: External Influences on the Business Enterprise .The emphasis should be on investigating the impact of external conditions on businesses and their responses to change in economic and market conditions, environmental issues, social and ethical issues and legal and self-regulatory constraints.

### A2 Units

Unit 7: Finance. The focus of this unit will be the preparation and interpretation of final accounts, sources of finance, interpretation of accounts, investment appraisal, absorption costing, breakeven analysis and budgeting.

Unit 9: This practical unit should be delivered through the planning and running of either a mini-enterprise or a virtual enterprise.

Unit 11: This unit provides the opportunity for an in-depth study of marketing.
