**Eligibility Criteria**

**To be measured at shortlisting, you must demonstrate on your application form precisely how you meet these criteria.**

- 5 GCSE's at grade A-C including Maths and English (or equivalent level qualification) with one in a science subject

**Essential Criteria (to be measured at interview)**

**Experience**

- At least six month's experience in the last five years of preparing and maintaining equipment and materials in a scientific environment.
- At least six month's experience in the last five years of carrying out risk assessments in relation to departmental processes.

**Skills and Abilities**

- Proven ability to work as part of a team and independently.
- Proven ability to maintain accurate work records and inventories within strict deadlines.

**Knowledge**

- Knowledge of Health & Safety legislation as it relates to the work of a school.

**Desirable Criteria (used for shortlisting only in the event of a large number of applicants)**

- A-Level at grade A-C in a scientific subject or 1 years' experience in the last five years working as a technician or teacher in a school
- A good working knowledge of the school science curriculum up to and including A-level
